## - Teacher's Report - Mrs. Bernhardt

- Kindergarten - They are finishing a farm animal unit that concluded with the amazing "Barnyard Moosical." Thank you to the parents for the costumes. They are completing an Inside Our Bodies unit in PLTW. THey are working on their Kindergarten Memories book. Thank you for ice pops on Friday and RIF books.
- 1st grade - They are working on the end of the year writing memory (first grade memories, second grade expectations, summer). In math, they are working with 2 d and 3 d shapes. In fundations, they are working on suffixes (-s, -ed, -ing). They loved the STAR Lab, the book fair, and the plant sale.
- 2nd grade - They are working on repeated addition in preparation for multiplication. They are writing about butterflies and sunflower life cycles, second grade memories, and opinion writing. In Fundations, they are working on fluency and comprehension practice. There are fun end of the year read-a-louds. In PLTW they are working on form and function (plants, seed dispersal).
- 3rd grade - June 8th - Author's Celebration. Thank you to all of the families coming to celebrate the young authors. They will be reading Peter Pan. In math, they are completing Module 6 (geometry, measurement and
data). They are learning about the Amazon Rainforest. Information will be sent home about the last week of school and celebrations.
- 4th grade - They have been working diligently on their published books, and the students have written beautiful poetry in their anthologies. They are progressing through concepts of geometry and will move to decimals. Students have made great strides on ST-Math. They are learning about living organisms in science as they explore different characteristics of various plants and animals. They have enjoyed learning about how authors write and illustrate graphic novels from Smithtown graduate and renowned author, George O'Connor. They also enjoyed a virtual visit with Chris Ravenstein, the author of Lemoncello's Library and Shine. Students also learned about seeds and plants through the Long Island Science Center, and they learned about the Food Web in a program with John Shiels and Western Suffolk BOCES. They were excited for the show Prismatics on field day and loved the Frankel Sisters performance. They want to thank the PTA for their sponsored events and programs.
- 5th grade - In math, they just wrapped up a geometry unit, and have started the module on coordinates. In ELA, they are finishing reading Restart. In PLTW, students have been working with the HS robotics team where they have been learning more about coding. They have also been studying properties of matter. In SS, they are finishing their government unit.
- RISE - In ELA, they are working on a unit on animals and animal babies. They had a fantastic time at Bowlero!
